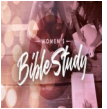
### July 21, 2024

**Human Care Ministry**  
The Free Food Box Giveaway is the 3rd Saturday of the month.

Each family receives a food box, and a prayer from Deacon Danner. Included in the food box is information designed to help them in their walk with Jesus or to bring them to Jesus. We look forward to the 3rd Saturday of the month and the opportunity to help others.

The grant from the Lutheran Thrift Shop helps to fill our food pantry, and your donations fill in the gap. Thank you for your donations to the food pantry and remember to shop at the West Valley Lutheran Thrift Shop on 107th and Peoria Ave. Volunteers are needed to process, cashier, or help as needed. It’s a pressure free job with great benefits – like making new friends!

**We need your help!** Households cannot use SNAP benefits to buy any nonfood items such as cleaning supplies, paper products, and other household supplies. Therefore, in addition to food, we want to help with: **deodorant, toilet paper, paper towels, shower gel, shaving gel, shampoo, soap, toothpaste (we have a lot of toothbrushes), feminine products, and baby supplies. Items must be unopened.** We make available these types of items when they pick up their box if they need them.

**Orphan Grain Train donations** - Donations can be placed by the table in the Narthex (Human Care Corner) We will take any listed on the sign but are running low on men's clothing, so all men's clothing donations will be greatly appreciated.

**While sleeping mats are still being made, we ask that you do not bring bags to church until further notice. This will give us time to use the bags you have already donated. Thank you.**

**Sleeping Mats for the Homeless** Did you ever imagine those pesky overly abundant plastic grocery bags that pile up in our homes could make a positive difference in the life of a person on the streets? They most certainly can. Brave and intrepid volunteers here at Apostles are making sleeping mats from plastic bags. It takes 500-700 bags to make one mat. These mats are lightweight, easy to clean, and provide insulation and a barrier between the individual and the ground or floor.
